

- ◆ Why are you asking me all of these questions?
 - If your parents have questions, direct them to the FAQ page or to your school's administration.
- ◆ Why should I take this survey?
 - Do you ever get tired of adults thinking they know about your life? They don't! And this is your chance to tell them how it really is for you.
 - Bonus: your answers will help schools, nonprofits, and other youth organizations to make things better for YOU!
- ◆ Why do you ask such personal questions?
 - The survey asks personal questions because they help us understand what is going well for you and what challenges you are facing - in and out of the classroom.
 - We ask you directly because we adults don't know. We aren't growing up in the same time you are, so we can only guess what we think is going on. Answering honestly will help us understand you and your peers better.
- ◆ How do I know it's safe to answer honestly?
 - We don't collect personally identifiable information, and the data is collected and analyzed by The Legacy Center, in partnership with Search Institute (a nonprofit that supports youth development).
 - Your teachers, principals, and other school staff will never see your individual responses.
- ◆ Will I get in trouble for any of my answers?
 - Since we have no way of tracing your answers back to you, you will not get in trouble for your answers.
- ◆ What if I don't know what something is?
 - If you don't know what something is, you can skip the question or mark never, not applicable, or I don't know (depending on the response options).
 - You can also skip a question if you feel uncomfortable answering.
- ◆ Do I have to finish the entire thing?
 - We know it's long, but we need you to try to answer 120 questions for your survey to be included in the final results.
